STAY SAFE THIS SEASON

Help keep holiday moments merry by making sure safety is top of mind.

- While holiday shopping, keep bags in your trunk and don't leave valuables in plain sight.
- Some decorations can increase the risk of a home fire, especially if not monitored and used properly. Check light strings for signs of wear before decorating, and always unplug holiday lights before going to bed. If using a real tree in your holiday decorations, water it daily.
- Before traveling over the holidays, make a plan to have a trusted friend or family member check on your home and bring in mail. Lock all doors and windows before you leave.
- Following the festivities, gift boxes can serve as billboards for criminals driving through your neighborhood, and a dry tree poses a fire hazard. To enhance public safety, the City of Tallahassee will
